John Mullin Presents: WTKO North American International Karate Championship 2010

Date and Time: Sunday April 25th 2010 Check in at 8:30 AM Events begin at 9:30 am

Beginning events Children's Kata and followed by Children Kumite. Adult events to follow children with individual kata followed by individual kumite. Team events for follow adult events beginning with team kata followed by team kumite.

Place: St. Francis College 180 Remsen Street, Brooklyn Heights, Brooklyn, New York (off Court Street)

Registration Fee: One or two individual events \$60; Note early registration discount!

(Early registration before April 19th is \$50)

Team events \$45 **(Registration before April 19th \$30)**

Spectator fee: Adult's \$10 Children under 14 years of age free, identification may be required.

NOTE: The promoter reserves the right to deny free entrance if the child's age is in question.

All WTKO passport holders that are current receive 10% discount on registration fees.

Payment: Checks (by April 19th) Money orders, cash. Checks made payable to WTKO

Awards: Kata and Kumite and Team events awarded 1st 2nd 3rd Medals

All registered participants will receive an award of participation

Special award to the most outstanding athlete. (must compete in two events)

Dress Code: Clean traditional white karate gi. No colored or mixed colored karate gi's.

Officials: white shirt and tie. Black belts may be used to judge rounds wearing their gi.

Forms: Katas used in preliminary rounds will be Heian katas one through five, appropriate to the level of the competitor. Semi-final and final rounds will be kata of choice. Top six to semi finals.

Sparring: Shobu Ippon (One point, half points may be awarded for a total of one point).

No Contact to the face, head, neck, groin or to elbow or knee joints. Exceptions; light contact to head area in senior adult divisions. **Any technique that endangers an athlete's safety may result in a disqualification.** All matches will be 2 minutes continuous time unless stopped by the Chief Referee.

Equipment: Mandatory are mouth piece and protective mitts. Groin cup is optional. Head gear for all children under the age of 18. **Shin guards are not allowed.**

Coaching: There is no coaching from the side lines. **All spectators must remain in the spectators area** and not approach the ring. Exception; For the children's event their instructor or the instructors representative may be at ringside. Any instructor or representative at ringside must conduct themselves with dignity and courtesy. **The tournament officials reserve the right to remove anyone from the floor for inappropriate language or behavior towards officials, judges or competitors.**

SPECIAL NOTE: The tournament officials reserve the right to change or combine divisions if there are less than three competitors present. **All fees are non-refundable.**
